

## Denmark & Sweden – 7-Day Luxury Itinerary

Base in Copenhagen and Stockholm with curated dining, private guides, and refined local experiences.

### Full Day-to-Day Itinerary

#### Day 1 – Arrival in Copenhagen & Nyhavn / City Intro

- Arrive at Copenhagen Airport (CPH) and private transfer to your hotel. Luxury suggestions: Hotel d'Angleterre (central, classic luxury) or Nimb Hotel (Tivoli).
  - Settle in, then take a relaxed stroll along Nyhavn and the canal-lined streets.
  - Lunch: Ved Kajen (listed as Ved kjan — enjoy waterfront dining).
  - Afternoon: Visit Amalienborg Palace, Frederiks Kirke (The Marble Church) and Strøget for high-end shopping.
  - Dinner: Nobu Copenhagen reservation for a refined Japanese experience (book VIP table).
  - Evening: Optional private canal cruise for city lights.

#### Day 2 – Copenhagen: Culture, Food & Design

- Morning: Private guided tour of Christiansborg Palace and Rosenborg Castle (Crown Jewels display).
  - Stroll through Designmuseum Danmark and the stylish boutiques in Østerbro.
  - Lunch: Café Nyhavn or local Nordic bistro (you listed Café nytorv / Okko — pick Nytorv for classic charm).
  - Afternoon: Explore Tivoli Gardens (seasonal) or a private design-walk in Vesterbro.
  - Dinner: Kødbyens Fiskebar (Kodebyns fiskebar) — upscale seafood in the Meatpacking District.
  - Nightcap: Rooftop bar at your hotel or a private mixologist experience.

#### Day 3 – Copenhagen: Culinary & Coastal Escape

- Morning: Private visit to Torvehallerne (food market) with tasting stops; pick up artisan chocolates and smørrebrød samplings.
  - Option: Half-day private trip to Louisiana Museum of Modern Art (seaside museum, 30–40 min north) for modern art and coastal views.
  - Lunch: Marv & Ben (as listed) or a Michelin bistro in the city.
  - Afternoon: Relaxing spa or private sailing around the harbor.
  - Dinner: Nobu (if not used Day 1) or reserve a chef's table at Kokkeriet for Nordic tasting menu.

#### Day 4 – Transfer to Stockholm & Gamla Stan Intro

- Morning: Short flight or fast train to Stockholm (ARN). Private transfer to your hotel. Suggested stay: NOFO Hotel (as you listed) or upgrade to Grand Hôtel Stockholm for riverside luxury.
  - Afternoon: Walk through Gamla Stan (Old Town) — cobble lanes, Royal Palace, Stortorget square.
  - Lunch: Österlånggatan 17 area café / Bistro Sud (you listed Bistro sud and Österlanggatsn 17) — choose a cozy Old Town bistro.
  - Evening: Scenic boat ride in the archipelago (short sunset cruise if timing allows).
  - Dinner: Österlånggatan restaurant or Speceriat (as listed) for an intimate local meal.

#### Day 5 – Stockholm: Museums & Östermalm

- Morning: Visit Vasa Museum and/or ABBA The Museum (private guided option).
  - Stroll Djurgården and the royal parks.
  - Lunch: Café Nytorget-style bistro or revisit Bistro Sud if you prefer.
  - Afternoon: Explore Östermalm Market Hall and boutique shopping along Strandvägen.
  - Dinner: Fine dining at a Michelin or Nordic-Scandinavian restaurant (reserve in advance).

#### Day 6 – Stockholm: Södermalm & Archipelago

- Morning: Explore Södermalm / SoFo neighborhoods — independent designers, galleries, and vintage shops.
  - Lunch: Café Nytorget or a trendy Söder spot (you listed Okko — use as a lunch or café stop).
  - Afternoon: Private archipelago cruise to a nearby island for a seafood lunch or scenic walk (half-day).
  - Dinner: Final celebratory dinner at Speceriat or another top Stockholm restaurant (reserve chef's table if available).

### Day 7 – Departure

- Morning: Leisurely breakfast at the hotel, last-minute stroll or souvenir shopping.
  - Check out and private transfer to Stockholm Arlanda Airport (ARN) for departure.

### Practical Travel Info

- Main Airports: Copenhagen (CPH), Stockholm Arlanda (ARN). Domestic transfers by short flight or high-speed train (Copenhagen ↔ Stockholm).
  - Local Transport: Taxis, private transfers, efficient metro systems (Copenhagen Metro / Stockholm metro). For luxury travel use private chauffeurs.
  - Hotels (luxury suggestions): Copenhagen — Hotel d'Angleterre, Nimb; Stockholm — Grand Hôtel, NOFO Hotel (as listed).
  - Power / Plugs: Type C/F (220–230V) in Denmark & Sweden.
  - Currency: Danish Krone (DKK), Swedish Krona (SEK) — cards accepted widely.
  - Districts / Areas Covered: Copenhagen — Nyhavn, Mariahilf/Strøget equivalent (central), Vesterbro (Meatpacking), Østerbro; Stockholm — Gamla Stan, Östermalm, Södermalm, Djurgården.

### Travel Tips & Essentials

- Book restaurants & experiences well in advance (Nobu, Købbyens Fiskebar, chef's tables).
- Weather: Pack layers — Scandinavia can be chilly year-round; windproof jacket recommended for coastal days.
- Tipping: Modest — rounding up or 5–10% in restaurants is appreciated but not mandatory.
- Local culture: Scandinavian punctuality — arrive on time for tours & reservations.
- Language: Danish/Swedish — English widely spoken in tourist and dining scenes.
- Special note: For the archipelago cruise, request a private skipper or charter for the most luxurious experience.
