

Indonesia Itinerary 1 — Bali & Ubud (10 Days / 9 Nights)

Theme: Tropical Luxury, Culture & Wellness

Day 1 – Arrival in Bali (Denpasar)

- Arrive at Ngurah Rai International Airport (DPS).
- Private transfer to The Legian Bali or Alila Seminyak.
- Relax by the beach and enjoy a welcome Balinese dinner at Merah Putih.

Day 2 – Seminyak & Canggu Exploration

- Morning coffee at Revolver Espresso.
- Explore boutique shops, temples, and beaches of Canggu.
- Lunch at La Brisa Bali with ocean views.
- Evening: rooftop sunset cocktails at Potato Head Beach Club.

Day 3 – Uluwatu Day Trip

- Visit Uluwatu Temple perched on a cliff.
- Watch the Kecak fire dance at sunset.
- Dinner at Sundara Jimbaran.

Day 4 – Transfer to Ubud (2 hrs)

- En route, stop at Tegenungan Waterfall.
- Check in at Four Seasons Sayan or Capella Ubud.
- Dinner at Locavore (Michelin Guide restaurant).

Day 5 – Ubud Culture & Rice Terraces

- Morning yoga and spa session.
- Visit Tegallalang Rice Terraces and Ubud Palace.
- Lunch at Swept Away overlooking the river.
- Explore Monkey Forest and local art markets.

Day 6 – North Bali Adventure

- Day trip to Ulun Danu Beratan Temple and Handara Gate.
- Visit Gitgit Waterfall.
- Dinner back in Ubud.

Day 7 – Nusa Penida Day Trip

- Speedboat from Sanur (30–45 mins).
- Visit Kelingking Beach, Angel's Billabong, Broken Beach.
- Return to Bali in evening.

Day 8 – Spa & Leisure Day

- Relax at your resort.
- Spa treatment + Balinese cooking class.
- Sunset dinner at La Lucciola.

Day 9 – Beach Club & Sunset

- Explore Finns Beach Club or Savaya Bali.
- Dinner at Sarong restaurant.

Day 10 – Departure from Bali

- Private transfer to airport.

Indonesia Travel Info & Tips

Getting There

- Main international airports:
 - Bali (DPS – Ngurah Rai International Airport) – direct flights from Singapore, Dubai, Kuala Lumpur, Bangkok, and major Indian cities.
 - Jakarta (CGK – Soekarno-Hatta International Airport) – main gateway for Java and international connections.
- Domestic flights:

- Garuda Indonesia, Batik Air, and AirAsia offer frequent connections between islands (Jakarta → Yogyakarta → Bali → Lombok).
- Short fast boat transfers (1.5–2 hrs) connect Bali to the Gili Islands and Nusa Penida.

Best Time to Visit

- Dry season (April–October) – best for beaches, temples, diving, and outdoor exploration.
- Rainy season (November–March) – lush greenery but expect short tropical showers.
- Peak travel months: June–September.

Travel Tips

- Currency – Indonesian Rupiah (IDR).
- Plug type – C & F (European-style round pins).
- Visa – Most nationalities can get Visa on Arrival (30 days), extendable once.
- Internal transfers between islands are easy via short flights or boats.
- Respect local customs – cover shoulders and knees at temples.
- Tap water is not drinkable — use bottled water only.



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Indonesia Itinerary 2 — Java, Bali & Gili Islands (15 Days / 14 Nights)

Theme: Culture, Nature & Island Escape

Day 1 – Arrival in Jakarta (Java)

- Arrive at Soekarno-Hatta Airport (CGK).
- Check in at The Langham Jakarta.
- Evening city tour: Monas Tower, Menteng district.

Day 2 – Yogyakarta

- Morning flight to Yogyakarta (1 hr).
- Explore Borobudur Temple, Prambanan Temple, and Malioboro Street.
- Stay at Amanjiwo Resort.

Day 3 – Mount Bromo Volcano (East Java)

- Flight or private drive to Surabaya → transfer to Mount Bromo area.
- Sunset view at Penanjakan Point.
- Stay overnight at Plataran Bromo.

Day 4 – Sunrise at Mount Bromo & Transfer to Bali

- Early morning jeep ride for sunrise.
- Flight from Surabaya to Denpasar (1.5 hrs).
- Check in at Four Seasons Jimbaran Bay.

Day 5 – South Bali Highlights

- Visit Uluwatu Temple, Padang Padang Beach, and Dreamland Beach.
- Dinner at Rock Bar Ayana.

Day 6 – Seminyak & Canggu

- Beach hopping and café culture.
- Lunch at Nook or Shelter Café.
- Evening at Potato Head Beach Club.

Day 7 – Ubud (Central Bali)

- Transfer to Ubud. Visit Tegallalang Rice Terraces.
- Stay at Mandapa Ritz-Carlton Reserve.
- Dinner at Bridges Bali.

Day 8 – Waterfalls & Temples

- Visit Tibumana Waterfall, Goa Gajah, and Tirta Empul Temple.
- Optional yoga or cooking class.

Day 9 – Bali to Gili Islands (by Fast Boat 1.5–2 hrs)

- Depart from Padangbai Harbor.
- Check in at Hotel Pearl of Trawangan or KATAMARAN Resort (Gili Trawangan).
- Enjoy snorkeling, biking, or beach bars.

Day 10–11 – Gili Islands Leisure

- Island-hop between Gili Trawangan, Gili Air, and Gili Meno.
- Water sports & sunset dining on the beach.

Day 12 – Return to Bali (2 hrs by boat)

- Back to Bali → stay near Sanur or Nusa Dua.

Day 13 – East Bali Day Trip

- Visit Lempuyang Temple (Gates of Heaven), Tirta Gangga, and Virgin Beach.
- Lunch at Bali Asli Restaurant.

Day 14 – Spa & Shopping in Seminyak

- Relaxing spa day, last-minute shopping.
- Dinner at Metis or Bambu.

Day 15 – Departure

- Transfer to Denpasar Airport (DPS).
