Full Day-to-Day Itinerary

Day 1 – Arrival & Florence Intro

- Arrive at Florence Airport (FLR) or Rome → high-speed train to Florence SMN. Transfer to your hotel. Luxury suggestions: Four Seasons Hotel Firenze, Belmond Villa San Michele, or Hotel Savoy.
- Afternoon: Settle in and stroll to the Duomo area; admire Brunelleschi's dome and Baptistery.

- Stroll through Piazza della Signoria and view the sculptures at the Loggia dei Lanzi.
- Lunch: Burro & Acciughe or Osteria Pastella (as listed).
- Afternoon: Explore Oltrarno — artisan workshops, Pitti Palace, and Boboli Gardens.
- Dinner: Il Santo Bevitore or Il Sant'Bevitore (as listed).
- Must try: Antica Porchetta Granieri (for local porchetta specialties).

Day 3 – Florence: Day Trips / Leisure

- Option 1: Chianti day trip — private wine estate visits, cellar tours, and vineyard lunch.
- Option 2: Siena & San Gimignano day trip (private driver) for medieval towns and vistas.

- Dinner: Enjoy Venetian specialties and cicchetti at a top osteria.

Day 7 – Transfer to Milan & Arrival

- Morning: Private water taxi to Piazzale Roma, then high-speed train to Milan Centrale. Transfer to your hotel. Luxury suggestions: Hotel Principe di Savoia, Armani Hotel Milano, or Bulgari Hotel Milano.
- Afternoon: Explore Duomo di Milano, Galleria Vittorio Emanuele II, and Piazza del Duomo.
- Lunch: Emporio Armani Milan (as listed) or a stylish Milanese brasserie.
- Dinner: DG Martini Milano (as listed) or a top Milan restaurant (reserve in advance).

Day 8 – Milan: Design, Shopping & Culture

- Morning: Visit Brera district, Pinacoteca di Brera, and the boutiques in Brera and Quadrilatero della Moda.

- Dinner: Final celebratory dinner at a high-end Milanese restaurant (your pick from the list or a Michelin choice).

Day 9 – Departure

- Morning: Leisurely breakfast, last-minute shopping or espresso.
- Check out and private transfer to Milan Malpensa (MXP) or Milano Linate (LIN) for departure.

- Dining: Keep printed confirmations for special reservations. Afternoon siesta in small towns means some places close mid-afternoon.
- Packing: Light layers for city days and a smart outfit for upscale dinners.
- Must-try local dishes: Florentine steak, handmade pasta, Venetian seafood and cicchetti, Milanese risotto (risotto alla Milanese).
- Local tips: In Venice, use private water taxi for door-to-door convenience; prebook to avoid long waits.
