- Walk around the Japanese Gardens and Hotel de Paris gardens

- Stroll through Le Rocher (Old Town) and visit Prince's Palace
- See Monaco Cathedral and Oceanographic Museum
- Explore Port Hercules – luxury yachts and cafés
- Evening drinks at a rooftop bar or Monte Carlo beach

#### Day 3 – Optional Day Trip

- Short drive or train to nearby Nice, Menton
- Explore markets, seaside walks, or perfumeries in Eze
